19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
20	Section 1. The Legislature hereby finds, determines,
21	and declares all of the following:
22	(1) The current economic climate in the United
23	States and in Alabama in particular has created an environment
24	of hardship in the public and private sectors.
25	(2) The comprehensive effect of economic hardship on
26	the education system is a detriment to the interests of

students, as a result of the potential for proration of education funds and cuts in education services.

(3) It is in the best interest of Morgan County schools that the Morgan County Legislative Delegation cause to be delivered temporary additional funds to the school systems for the purpose of alleviating budget stresses that otherwise may result in a deterioration in the quality of education for the youth of Morgan County.

Section 2. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law, the proceeds allocated to Morgan County pursuant to Act 2010-135, 2010 Regular Session, from the in-lieu-of-taxes payments made by the Tennessee Valley Authority for fiscal years 2012 and 2013 shall be distributed as follows:

- (1) The first \$125,000 shall be distributed among the school systems in Hartselle, Decatur and Morgan County to be used expressly for the support and benefit of each system's robotics programs as follows:
 - a. Decatur -- \$55,000
 - b. Morgan County -- \$50,000
- c. Hartselle -- \$20,000
 - (2) Fifty percent of the remaining proceeds to be divided among the school systems in Hartselle, Decatur, and Morgan County for teachers and personnel expenses except that the proceeds shall not be expended for administrative purposes.
 - (3) Thirty percent of the remaining proceeds to be divided among the school systems in Hartselle, Decatur, and

Morgan County for technological purposes in the schools in
each system, the amounts of which shall be determined by each
school system except that the proceeds shall not be expended
for administrative purposes.

- (4) Twenty percent of the remaining proceeds to be divided among teachers, librarians, and educational personnel in the school systems in Hartselle, Decatur, and Morgan County. Such amounts shall be used exclusively for instructional and teaching materials and supplies, as determined by each school. Any excess funds shall be divided among each school in the respective school systems.
- (b) The proceeds from the payments distributed for each fiscal year pursuant to subdivisions 2 (a)(2), (3) and(4) shall be based on the previous year's average daily student enrollment in the respective school systems.
- (c) Any school system that does not have at least one month's expenditures in reserve shall receive and expend the proceeds without regard to the provisions of subdivisions 2 (a)(2), (3) and (4). When such school system has at least one month's expenditures in reserve, the provisions of subdivisions 2 (a)(2), (3) and (4) shall be applicable.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
