Relating to Bibb County; providing for the budgetary operations within the office of the tax assessor/collector; providing that the office shall be financed on a pro rata share basis from proceeds of state, county, and municipal ad valorem taxes collected in the county; and providing for supplemental effect.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The Tax Assessor/Collector of Bibb County, respectively, shall be responsible for the budgetary operations and functions of his or her office. The expenses of the office shall be financed on a pro rata share basis from the proceeds of any state, county, and municipal ad valorem taxes collected in the county in the same manner as the salary of the tax assessor/collector is paid pursuant to Section 40-6A-2, Code of Alabama 1975. Any funds retained by the office pursuant to this act shall be used solely for the operation of the office, respectively, subject to approval of the budget for the office by the county commission in the same manner as the budget is currently approved.

Section 2. The provisions of this act are supplemental. It shall be construed in pari materia with other laws regulating the office of the Tax Assessor/Collector in
