10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT  
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13 Relating to Bibb County; providing for the budgetary  
14 operations within the office of the tax assessor/collector;  
15 providing that the office shall be financed on a pro rata  
16 share basis from proceeds of state, county, and municipal ad  
17 valorem taxes collected in the county; and providing for  
18 supplemental effect.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. The Tax Assessor/Collector of Bibb  
21 County, respectively, shall be responsible for the budgetary  
22 operations and functions of his or her office. The expenses of  
23 the office shall be financed on a pro rata share basis from  
24 the proceeds of any state, county, and municipal ad valorem  
25 taxes collected in the county in the same manner as the salary  
26 of the tax assessor/collector is paid pursuant to Section  
27 40-6A-2, Code of Alabama 1975. Any funds retained by the

1 office pursuant to this act shall be used solely for the  
2 operation of the office, respectively, subject to approval of  
3 the budget for the office by the county commission in the same  
4 manner as the budget is currently approved.

5 Section 2. The provisions of this act are  
6 supplemental. It shall be construed in pari materia with other  
7 laws regulating the office of the Tax Assessor/Collector in  
8 Bibb County; however, those laws or parts of laws which are in  
9 direct conflict or inconsistent herewith are repealed.

10 Section 3. This act shall become effective  
11 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
12 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
