Relating to Shelby County; to provide for the assessment and collection of an additional court cost in certain civil and criminal cases; and to provide for the distribution of the additional cost.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. This act shall apply only in Shelby

County.

Section 2. (a) (1) In addition to any court costs now authorized in the circuit, district, and juvenile courts of Shelby County, there shall be assessed and collected an additional court cost of twenty dollars (\$20) in all civil and criminal cases except small claims, traffic cases, and protection form abuse cases pursuant to Chapter 5 of Title 30, Code of Alabama 1975.

- (2) In addition to any court costs now authorized in the circuit and district courts of Shelby County, there shall be assessed and collected an additional court cost of five dollars (\$5) in all traffic cases.
- (b) The additional court costs collected pursuant to subsection (a) shall be distributed as follows:
- 23 (1) Forty-five percent to the district attorney to 24 be used for any legitimate law enforcement purpose.

1	(2) Forty-five percent to the Community Corrections
2	Fund to be used for operational and administrative expenses of
3	the program.
4	(3) Ten percent to the Judicial Administration Fund
5	to be used for administrative expenses of the local court
6	system.
7	Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
8	first day of the third month following its passage and
9	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
