18	Section 1. This act shall apply only in Shelby
19	County.
20	Section 2. (a)(1) In addition to any court costs now
21	authorized in the circuit, district, and juvenile courts of
22	Shelby County, there shall be assessed and collected an
23	additional court cost of twenty dollars (\$20) in all civil and
24	criminal cases except small claims, traffic cases, and
25	protection form abuse cases pursuant to Chapter 5 of Title 30,
26	Code of Alabama 1975.

1 (2) In addition to any court costs now authorized in 2 the circuit and district courts of Shelby County, there shall 3 be assessed and collected an additional court cost of five 4 dollars (\$5) in all traffic cases.

5 (b) The additional court costs collected pursuant to 6 subsection (a) shall be distributed as follows:

7 (1) Forty-five percent to the district attorney to
8 be used for any legitimate law enforcement purpose.

9 (2) Forty-five percent to the Community Corrections 10 Fund to be used for operational and administrative expenses of 11 the program.

12 (3) Ten percent to the Judicial Administration Fund
13 to be used for administrative expenses of the local court
14 system.

Section 3. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
