4 District may be annexed into any municipality by local law.

5 (c) Subsection (b) shall not apply to any  
6 municipality incorporated after the ratification of this  
7 amendment which includes any part of the Stockton Landmark  
8 District.

9 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment  
10 shall be held at the general election in November 2012 in  
11 accordance with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama  
12 of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official  
13 Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as  
14 amended, and the election laws of this state.

15 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall  
16 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional  
17 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the  
18 following description of the substance or subject matter of  
19 the proposed constitutional amendment:

20 "Relating to Baldwin County, proposing an amendment  
21 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to define the Stockton  
22 Landmark District within the county and to prohibit the  
23 annexation by local law of any property within the district  
24 into any municipality.

25 "Proposed by Act \_\_\_\_\_."

26 This description shall be followed by the following  
27 language:
