13 Relating to Madison County and the Twenty-third
14 Judicial Circuit; to amend Section 1 of Act 2007-471, 2007
15 Regular Session (Acts 2007, p. 992), to provide for the
16 assessment of the district attorney's fee in the municipal
17 court; and to provide further for the disbursement of the
18 district attorney's fee.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. Section 1 of Act 2007-471, 2007 Regular
21 Session (Acts 2007, p. 992), is amended to read as follows:

22 "Section 1. In all cases in the municipal, juvenile,
23 district, and circuit courts in Madison County and the
24 Twenty-third Judicial Circuit, a docket fee, hereinafter
25 referred to as a District Attorney's Fee, shall be assessed in
26 each case. The fees, when collected, shall be distributed
27 monthly to the District Attorney's Fund in the county or to

1 the fund that may be hereafter prescribed by law for the
2 District Attorney's Fee. The District Attorney's Fee shall be
3 in an amount equal to all docket fees or court costs which are
4 assessed in cases and distributed to the Fair Trial Tax Fund.
5 A three dollar (\$3) administrative fee from each assessed fee
6 shall be retained by the circuit clerk pursuant to Section
7 12-17-225.4(2), Code of Alabama 1975, when the case originates
8 in the juvenile, district, or circuit court, or by the
9 municipal court clerk to be deposited into a municipal court
10 clerk fund and used for administrative expenses when the case
11 originates in the municipal court."

12 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
13 first day of the third month following its passage and
14 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
