7 are herein conveyed to Coach Gene Chizik of the Auburn Tigers
8 Football program, who does us great honor with his presence in
9 the Alabama House of Representatives on this momentous

7 Game in Glendale, Arizona; and

8 WHEREAS, it is an honor and a privilege to recognize
9 this extraordinary Alabamian for his contributions to Auburn
10 University and to our State; now therefore,

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH

13 congratulate Coach Gene Chizik of Auburn University on his
