4 HONORING MRS. MARION ROSEMORE AND WELCOMING HER TO
5 THE STATE HOUSE.

7 WHEREAS, it is a great pleasure to recognize and
8 welcome Mrs. Marion Rosemore, a native Alabamian who
9 epitomizes the intrepid spirit that propels the success of the
10 American dream; and

11 WHEREAS, a graduate of Ramsey High School in
12 Birmingham, she married a hero of World War II, and together
13 they rose from humble beginnings to a business empire of
14 national scale, working long hours, living frugally, and
15 setting high goals with entrepreneurial vigor; and

16 WHEREAS, her late husband of 63 years, Dr. Fred
17 Rosemore, obtained his well-earned education with the GI Bill,
18 having served as a navigator in a B-17 shot down over Hungary
19 in World War II and imprisoned in a POW Camp until freed by
20 Allied Forces in 1945; and

21 WHEREAS, Mrs. Rosemore utilized her stenography and
22 secretarial skills as his business partner while her husband's
23 optometry practice in Fayette, Alabama, prospered and the
24 couple branched out into business ventures including
25 laundromats, apartment buildings, commercial rental property,
26 financial investments, motel, movie theaters, and WRBS in

1 Tuscaloosa, the first Black radio station in Alabama, among
2 numerous other enterprises; and

3 WHEREAS, in the late 1970s, the Rosemores founded
4 Pro-Med Capital, which merged with a sister company and is now
5 PMC Commercial Trust (PCC), listed on the New York Stock
6 Exchange; among the company's specialties are loans helping
7 people set up in business; and

8 WHEREAS, the Rosemores lived most of their life
9 together in Fayette, rearing their family of five children in
10 Alabama and personifying the values of family and community
11 while emphasizing the transcendent importance of a good
12 education; and

13 WHEREAS, no measure of merit may be detracted from
14 the standing of Mrs. Rosemore by the fact that she is the
15 mother-in-law of our friend and colleague, Representative
16 Johnny Mack Morrow; now therefore,

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
18 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we honor Mrs. Marion Rosemore
19 and, by copy of this resolution, we offer her a warm welcome
20 to the State House and convey our highest commendation for a
21 lifetime of achievement along with best wishes in all future
22 endeavors.
