WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tennessee Valley Authority
Act of 1933, the TVA Board of Directors and the U.S. Attorney
General are broadly empowered to administer and enforce the
act, as well as presidential executive orders related to TVA's
duties under the act; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 13112, February 3, 1999, requires federal agencies to control invasive noxious weed species and control and minimize negative economic, ecological, and human health impacts associated with noxious weeds, including invasive aquatic weeds; and

WHEREAS, the February 12, 2009, report of the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure Oversight Plan for the 111th Congress calls for a review and evaluation of TVA for environmental compliance and to monitor federal efforts to control the introduction and spreading of aquatic invasive species; and

WHEREAS, TVA has reduced its aquatic weed control program on Lake Guntersville, allowing the unsafe overgrowth
