8 COMMENDING HUNTSVILLE POLICE OFFICER GRADY THIGPEN
9 AS A NOMINEE FOR THE 2011 ALABAMA LEGISLATIVE MEDAL OF HONOR
10 FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT.

12 WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that we
13 recognize Huntsville Police Officer Grady Thigpen as a nominee
14 for the 2011 Alabama Legislative Medal of Honor for Law
15 Enforcement, Alabama's highest law enforcement award for
16 extraordinary courage in the line of duty; and

17 WHEREAS, on September 6, 2010, Officer Thigpen and
18 his assist were dispatched to check a suspicious vehicle
19 parked behind a church, where there had also been a report of
20 a gunshot fired in the immediate area; when Officer Thigpen
21 arrived, he saw a female seated on the ground three to five
22 feet in front of the vehicle, holding a gun to her mouth;
23 without hesitation, Officer Thigpen reached the female and
24 removed the weapon before she could discharge it; and

25 WHEREAS, Officer Thigpen's quick actions prevented
26 harm to a person who had already demonstrated suicidal intent
27 by firing a round just moments before he arrived on the scene;

1 his actions were remarkable in that once he recognized the
2 threat, he did not hesitate to take immediate action, which
3 resulted in preventing the person from taking her own life;

5 WHEREAS, Officer Thigpen demonstrated the ultimate
6 level of professionalism, dedication, and concern for others
7 at the risk of his own life; and

8 WHEREAS, Officer Thigpen is a worthy exemplar of
9 those caring and dedicated men and women who stand ever ready
10 to provide prompt and professional response in times of
11 crisis, and he is highly deserving of this distinguished
12 nomination for the Legislative Medal of Honor for Law
13 Enforcement; now therefore,

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
15 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby recognize and honor
16 Huntsville Police Officer Grady Thigpen as a nominee for the
17 2011 Legislative Medal of Honor for Law Enforcement and direct
18 that he receive a copy of this resolution as a token of our
19 admiration and esteem.
