contracts, as well as to promote the lowest practicable price
to minimize costs to taxpayers and property owners; now
therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That all state and local agencies entering into a contract for the repair or restoration of damage to public property caused by the April 27, 2011, tornadoes, whether subject to competitive bidding laws or not, are urged to utilize transparency in the contracting process.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That transparency is intended to include, but is not limited to, publicizing when the contracts are executed, to whom the contracts are awarded, whether the contract parties are resident individuals or entities, and whether the contract parties are minority-owned or woman-owned business entities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That State Superintendent of 16 17 Education Joseph B. Morton is respectfully requested to coordinate the transparency of contracts awarded for repairs 18 and restoration to public schools and other educational 19 20 facilities and properties and compile information regarding 21 these public contracts to be included in a quarterly report to the Legislature, beginning June 1, 2011. A copy of this 22 23 resolution shall be provided to the State Superintendent of 24 Education so that the expectations concerning this issue are 25 clearly conveyed and implemented.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That State Director of 27 Finance David Perry is respectfully requested to coordinate

the transparency of contracts awarded for repairs and 1 2 restoration to public properties, unrelated to schools or other educational facilities and properties, and compile 3 information regarding these public contracts to be included in 4 5 a quarterly report to the Legislature, beginning June 1, 2011. A copy of this resolution shall be provided to the State 6 7 Director of Finance so that the expectations concerning this issue are clearly conveyed and implemented. 8
