10	WHEREAS, it is with highest commendation that John
11	Noel is recognized for his exemplary record of professional
12	achievement and service to his country, state, and community;

15	heritage he honors and continues, Mr. Noel dates his Alabama
16	lineage to 1792 when his ancestor, Hans Kennamer, settled in

19	a Republican after the Civil War and another great-grandfather
20	followed the Confederate Army as a teenager, working as a
21	medic, and later became a physician; and
22	WHEREAS, both his grandfathers were physicians, and
23	one of his grandmothers had two brothers who were appointed as
24	federal judges, one in Montgomery and the other in Tulsa,
25	Oklahoma; his parents were small business owners who ran the
26	local drug store in Boaz, Alabama; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Noel graduated from Boaz High School
and earned a Degree in Electrical Engineering in 1957 from

Auburn University, working as a co-op student with the United

States Army at Redstone Arsenal; after graduation, he worked
in Ft. Worth, Texas, on the B-58 bomber and later in Chicago,

Illinois, on manufacturing controls; and

WHEREAS, after returning to Redstone, he eventually transferred to NASA in 1960 and was one of the charter employees of the Marshall Space Flight Center as NASA became a presence in Alabama; and

WHEREAS, during his career, he worked on the Redstone, Pershing, Jupiter, and Saturn 5 rockets along with the Space Shuttle, as well as other key projects, and on two occasions was aboard the shuttle on the pad at Kennedy Space Center; in a coincidental reflection of his family background, the experiments for which he was responsible were of a medical nature; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Noel retired from NASA in 1988 with a total of 33.3 years of government service and spent several more years working as a contractor assisting with NASA efforts before finally retiring and becoming very involved in Republican politics; and

WHEREAS, he was one of the few charter members of the Republican Men's Club and served as its president for a number of years; since 1997, he has served effectively as Chairman of the Madison County Republican Executive Committee; and
