3 WHEREAS, he is survived by his wife, Carolyn
4 Harborth; son, William S. (Linda) Harborth; two daughters,
5 Elizabeth (Gary) Gaines and Jeanne (Michael) Tibbett; and a
6 grandson, Christian Foster Gaines; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Harborth was a valued member of the
8 community; although his presence will be missed, his memory
9 will be cherished in the hearts and minds of those who were
10 fortunate to know him; now therefore,
