11 WHEREAS, it is a great privilege to convey highest  
12 commendation to Elois Primm Ramsey in recognition of her  
13 record of outstanding accomplishments and many years of

19 System, which was formerly one of four Mission Schools founded

21 graduated from Camden Academy High School; and

23 years, her academic credentials include a Bachelor of Arts  
24 Degree in Elementary Education from Knoxville College, where  
25 she received the Christian Education Character Award upon  
26 graduating, and a Master of Arts Degree in Education from the  
27 University of Alabama in Birmingham; and

1           WHEREAS, after teaching Elementary Education for  
2 several years in the Wilcox County School System, she taught  
3 Elementary Language Arts in the Shelby County School System  
4 until retirement, when she began tutoring adult education  
5 students in language in preparation for the G.E.D.; and

6           WHEREAS, she has been a dedicated volunteer in  
7 numerous community organizations and worthy causes; among her  
8 roles of leadership, she served as secretary for the Board of  
9 Lutheran Ministries of Alabama, corresponding secretary for  
10 the Camden Academy Birmingham Chapter Alumni Association,  
11 secretary of the Board of Directors of the Shepherd Center  
12 East, and secretary since its inception of the East Lake  
13 Community Corporation, a 501c3 organization founded to develop  
14 programs to improve the East Lake Community; she is a member  
15 of the Airport Neighborhood Advisory Board and the Eastern  
16 Block Watch Planning Board; and

17           WHEREAS, in addition, she served as an at-large  
18 member of the Birmingham Urban Forestry and Tree Commission,  
19 receiving the 2008 Friend of Urban Forestry Award, and was  
20 recipient of a plaque of appreciation for her volunteer work  
21 with "Keep Birmingham Beautiful"; she also volunteers annually  
22 with the March of Dimes, American Heart Association, and the  
23 Diabetes Association; and

24           WHEREAS, devoted to family and faith, she was  
25 married to the late Rhodolph B. Ramsey and is the proud mother  
26 of a son, Kelvin Gerard Ramsey, Sr., whose wife, Cynthia Rena
