4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of
6 Alabama of 1901, to prohibit the imposition of an occupational
7 tax in Tuscaloosa County.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. The following amendment to the
10 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
11 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
12 this act are fulfilled:

13 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

14 No privilege or license tax on the gross receipts of
15 any natural person derived from the conduct of a vocation,
16 occupation, calling, or profession may be levied in Tuscaloosa
17 County.

18 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
19 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the
20 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section
21 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
22 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
23 state.

24 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
25 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional

1 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
2 following description of the substance or subject matter of
3 the proposed constitutional amendment:

4 "Relating to Tuscaloosa County, proposing an
5 amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to prohibit
6 the imposition of an occupational tax.

7 "Proposed by Act _____."

8 This description shall be followed by the following
9 language:

10 "Yes () No ()."
