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SYNOPSIS: Section 36-25-7, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended in the 2010 First Special Session by Act No. 2010-764, prohibits a person from offering or giving anything to a public official or public employee, as well as members of their households or family, for the purpose of influencing official action. Similarly, this section prohibits a public official or public employee, as well as members of

official action.

To alleviate questions relating to vagueness and enforceability, this bill would clarify that the prohibited offer, gift, solicitation, or receipt of anything, as contemplated in Section 36-25-7, Code of Alabama 1975, as amended in the 2010 First Special Session by Act No. 2010-764, must be for the purpose of corruptly influencing official action.

(d) No public official or public employee, shall solicit or receive any money in addition to that received by the public official or public employee in an official capacity for advice or assistance on matters concerning the Legislature, lobbying a legislative body, an executive department or any public regulatory board, commission or other body of which he or she is a member. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit a public official or public employee from the performance of his or her official duties or responsibilities."

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
