1 126211-1:g:02/23/2011:EBO-AMF/ebo-prm 2 3 4 5 6 7 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, Children First Trust 8 Fund programs are required to be funded through a 9 10 separate appropriation in a separate act. 11 This bill would make an appropriation of \$42,112,181 from the Children First Trust Fund for 12 13 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, to the entities and for the purposes designated in Section 14 41-15B-2.2, Code of Alabama 1975. 15 16 This bill would provide for the deposit of 17 tobacco settlement revenues into the Children First 18 Trust Fund, would require the State Director of 19 Finance to notify each agency in writing of the 20 amount of each agency's anticipated allocation, 21 would require quarterly allocation to each agency, 22 and would condition allocations upon the receipt of 23 tobacco funds. 24 This bill would make an appropriation of 25 \$45,966,572 from other tobacco settlement funds for 26 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012.

1 This bill would also make a conditional 2 appropriation and allocation of any additional tobacco revenue on recommendation of the Director 3 4 of Finance, the Chairman of the House Government Finance and Appropriations Committee and the 5 Chairman of the Senate Finance and Taxation-General 6 7 Fund Committee, and approval of the Governor. 8 9 A BILL 10 TO BE ENTITLED 11 AN ACT 12 13 To make an appropriation of \$42,112,181 from the 14 Children First Trust Fund for the fiscal year ending September 15 30, 2012, to the entities and for the purposes designated in Section 41-15B-2.2, Code of Alabama 1975; to provide for the 16 17 deposit of tobacco settlement revenues into the Children First Trust Fund; to require written notification of anticipated 18 agency allocations by the State Director of Finance; to 19 20 require quarterly allocations; to condition allocations on 21 receipt of tobacco revenues; to make an appropriation of 22 \$45,966,572 from other tobacco settlement funds for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012; and to make a conditional 23 24 appropriation and allocation of additional tobacco revenues 25 upon the recommendation of the Director of Finance, the 26 Chairman of the House Government Finance and Appropriations 27 Committee and the Chairman of the Senate Finance and

Taxation-General Fund Committee, and the approval of the
 Governor.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) There is hereby appropriated from the Children First Trust Fund the sum of \$42,112,181 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, to the entities and for the purposes designated in Section 41-15B-2.2, Code of Alabama 1975 as follows, per the approved plan of investment for each agency:

(b) (1) All tobacco revenues from the tobacco
settlement received by the state previously designated for the

Children First Trust Fund shall be deposited to the Children
 First Trust Fund within 30 calendar days of receipt of those
 tobacco revenues.

4 (2) The Director of Finance shall notify each agency
5 and the Department of Children's Affairs in writing prior to
6 September 1, 2011, of the dollar amount of the allocation
7 expected to be received by the agency from the Children First
8 Trust Fund in the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012.

(3) At the beginning of each quarter of the fiscal 9 10 year ending September 30, 2012, the respective agency shall be allocated at least one-fourth of the total amount appropriated 11 12 and allocated to the agency for that fiscal year when tobacco 13 revenues are available for the respective agency. In the event 14 tobacco revenues are not available for the respective agency 15 until later in the fiscal year then the respective agency shall be allocated an equal quarterly allotment for the 16 17 quarters that funds are available at the beginning of those quarters. Such allocation shall be made and be available for 18 expenditure by the agency within five working days of the 19 commencement of the quarter. If additional sums are 20 21 appropriated or allocated, or both, during the fiscal year, 22 these sums shall be equally allocated to the respective agency 23 among the remaining quarters of the fiscal year or may be 24 allocated to the respective agency in one sum if revenues are 25 available. The Department of Children's Affairs shall be 26 notified in writing of all appropriations and allocations from 27 the Children First Trust Fund by the Director of Finance.

(4) Allocations from the Children First Trust Fund
 are conditioned upon the receipt of tobacco revenues.

3 (c) Allocations received pursuant to Section 1 shall
4 be expended in accordance with Section 41-15B-2.2, Code of
5 Alabama 1975.

6 (d) At the conclusion of the fiscal year, any 7 remaining sums in the Children First Trust Fund shall remain 8 in the fund and shall not revert to the General Fund or to any 9 other fund, except as provided by HB____ or SB____ of the 2011 10 Regular Session, if enacted into law.

Section 2. In addition to the appropriation herein above made, there is hereby appropriated from additional tobacco settlement funds the sum of \$45,966,572 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012 to the following entities:

20 Section 3. Any additional tobacco revenues available 21 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2012, shall be 22 conditionally appropriated, conditioned upon the 23 recommendation of the Director of Finance, the Chairman of the House Government Finance and Appropriations Committee and the
 Chairman of the Senate Finance and Taxation-General Fund
 Committee, and approval of the Governor.

4 Section 4. The Executive Budget Office and the Director of Finance shall allot funds appropriated from the 5 Children First Trust Fund only following the certification by 6 7 the Commissioner of the Department of Children's Affairs that a plan of investment has been approved for each agency. The 8 Commissioner of the Department of Children's Affairs shall 9 10 prescribe the form and format on which each agency receiving appropriated funds herein shall submit a plan of investment of 11 12 said appropriated funds. The plan of investment shall include, 13 but not be limited to, a minimum of four (4) guality assurance 14 items on which a periodic report, as required by the approved 15 plan of investment, is made and as audited by the Examiners of Public Accounts. Quality assurance items shall include the 16 17 number of children receiving service, an identifiable measure of success of services provided and a prioritized standard of 18 successful measures for future plans of investment. It is the 19 intent of the Legislature that the Commissioner of the 20 21 Department of Children's Affairs shall be responsible for 22 providing a standard of measurement by which a clear 23 determination can be made through operational reporting and 24 audit reporting of a measurable success of funds appropriated and invested from the Children First Trust Fund; insure funds 25 26 appropriated herein are invested in viable programs; insure 27 and promote the leverage of appropriated funds herein in every

1 possible manner and coordinated in all possible ways the 2 investment of funds by each service provider to insure that no unproductive expenditures or duplication occurs. The 3 4 Commissioner of the Department of Children's Affairs shall notify legislators representing the area where a grant from 5 6 the Children First Trust Fund is designated. The notification 7 shall occur ten days before the funds reach the recipient 8 agency.

9 Section 5. The Commissioner of the Department of 10 Children's Affairs shall report each approved plan of investment to the Joint Interim Legislative Oversight 11 12 Committee and the Alabama Children's Policy Council. The 13 Commissioner, upon the request of the service agency, may 14 approve an adjusted plan of investment. It is the intent of 15 the Legislature that funds appropriated from the Children First Trust Fund be directed to meet the most immediate needs 16 17 of children as changing conditions may develop.

Section 6. Should any provision of this act be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remaining provisions of the act.

21 Section 7. This act shall become effective 22 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or 23 upon its otherwise becoming a law.
