11 To amend Section 2-6-12 of the Code of Alabama 1975,
12 providing for a continuing annual appropriation under certain
13 conditions to the Agriculture Center Board for the purpose of
14 renovating Garrett Coliseum, to delay the beginning fiscal
15 year of the appropriations.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. Section 2-6-12 of the Code of Alabama
18 1975, is amended to read as follows:

19 "§2-6-12.

20 "(a) Beginning in the fiscal year ending September
21 30, ~~2012~~ 2013, and in each fiscal year thereafter there shall
22 be appropriated from the State General Fund to the Alabama
23 Agriculture Center Board the sum of eight hundred thousand
24 dollars (\$800,000).

25 "(b) This annual appropriation shall be in addition
26 to any and all other appropriations to the Alabama Agriculture
27 Center Board. The annual appropriation to the board in the

1 amount of eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) shall
2 continue in each succeeding fiscal year as long as a
3 restoration, renovation, and improvement agreement of at least
4 thirty million dollars (\$30,000,000) remains in effect between
5 the board and any public institution or corporation of the
6 State of Alabama for the renovation and rehabilitation of
7 Garrett Coliseum and the Alabama Agriculture Center, located
8 in Montgomery, Alabama.

9 "(c) In the fiscal year following the expiration or
10 termination of the above agreement, the provisions of this
11 continuing appropriation shall cease. However, in any event,
12 the continuing appropriation shall cease and no longer be in
13 effect after fiscal year ~~2041~~ 2042.

14 "(d) The appropriation authority granted in this
15 article shall become null and void after September 30, ~~2014~~
16 2015, if by that time the board has not entered into a
17 restoration, renovation, and improvement agreement with any
18 public institution or other entity through which the use of
19 private funding is primarily used to restore, renovate, and
20 improve the facility."

21 Section 2. This act shall become effective
22 immediately following its passage and approval by the
23 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
