10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT

13 To alter, rearrange, and extend the boundary lines
14 and corporate limits of the City of Piedmont in Calhoun
15 County.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

17 Section 1. The boundary lines and corporate limits
18 of the City of Piedmont in Calhoun County are altered,
19 rearranged, and extended to include within the corporate
20 limits of the municipality, in addition to the lands now
21 included, all of the following territory:

22 COMMENCE AT A 3" PIPE MARKING THE NW CORNER OF THE
23 NE1/4-NE1/4 OF SECTION 34, T-12-S, R-10-E, THENCE S76°29'21"E
24 647.61' TO A 1/2" REBAR CAPPED(CA-497-LS) ON THE SOUTHERLY R/W
25 OF CALHOUN COUNTY ROAD #33 (80' R/W), SAID POINT BEING THE
26 POINT OF BEGINNING, THENCE CONTINUE ALONG SAID R/W ALONG A
27 CURVE WITH A RADIUS OF 978.23' AND A CHORD BEARING AND

1 DISTANCE OF S71°03'49"E 112.38' TO A 1/2" REBAR
2 CAPPED(CA-497-LS), THENCE CONTINUE ALONG SAID R/W S74°21'39"E
3 378.27' TO A POINT AT THE INTERSECTION OF CALHOUN COUNTY ROAD
4 #33 (80' R/W) AND U.S. HIGHWAY #278 (R/W VARIES), THENCE ALONG
5 THE WESTERLY R/W OF U.S. HIGHWAY #278 (R/W VARIES) ALONG A
6 CURVE WITH A RADIUS OF 2966.07' AND A CHORD BEARING AND
7 DISTANCE OF S42°48'15"W 210.17' TO A R/W MARKER, THENCE
8 CONTINUE ALONG SAID R/W S40°56'56"W 201.54' TO A POINT IN THE
9 CENTER OF TERRAPIN CREEK, THENCE LEAVING SAID R/W AND ALONG
10 THE CENTER OF SAID TERRAPIN CREEK, THE FOLLOWING BEARINGS AND
11 DISTANCES: N32°21'55"W 123.30' TO A POINT, THENCE N32°33'56"W
12 137.67' TO A POINT, THENCE N57°09'09"W 114.74' TO A POINT,
13 THENCE LEAVING SAID CENTER OF SAID TERRAPIN CREEK N14°06'32"E
14 167.51' TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 2.47 ACRES MORE
15 OR LESS.

16 Section 2. In accordance with Section 11-42-6(b) of
17 the Code of Alabama 1975, a map showing what territory is
18 proposed to be annexed to the City of Piedmont is on file in
19 the office of the Judge of Probate in Calhoun County, Alabama,
20 and the map is open to the inspection of the public.

21 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
22 first day of the third month following its passage and
23 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
