11 To propose a constitutional amendment to reauthorize  
12 the Forever Wild Land Trust for a 20-year period from fiscal  
13 year 2012-2013 to fiscal year 2031-2032.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

15 Section 1. The following amendment to the  
16 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and  
17 shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a  
18 majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in  
19 accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution  
20 of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

21 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

22 All moneys paid to the Forever Wild Land Trust  
23 pursuant to Section 7 of Amendment 543 of the Constitution of  
24 Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 7 of Section 219.07  
25 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama  
26 of 1901, as amended, shall continue to be paid for a 20-year

1 period beginning with the 2012-2013 fiscal year retroactive to  
2 October 1, 2012, and ending in the fiscal year 2031-2032.

3 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment  
4 shall be held on Tuesday November 6, 2012, and shall be held  
5 in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the Constitution of  
6 Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 285 of the  
7 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901,  
8 as amended, and the election laws of this state.

9 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall  
10 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional  
11 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the  
12 following description of the substance or subject matter of  
13 the proposed constitutional amendment:

14 "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of  
15 Alabama of 1901, relating to the Forever Wild Land Trust, to  
16 reauthorize the trust for a 20-year period.

17 "Proposed by Act \_\_\_\_\_."

18 This description shall be followed by the following  
19 language:

20 "Yes ( ) No ( )."
