10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT

13 Relating to the City of Prattville in Autauga and  
14 Elmore Counties; authorizing the city council to provide for  
15 the sale of draft beer with certain exceptions by retail  
16 licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, subject to  
17 voter approval at a referendum.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. This act shall apply to the regulation of  
20 the sale and distribution of alcoholic beverages in the City  
21 of Prattville in Autauga County and Elmore County.

22 Section 2. The city council, by resolution or  
23 ordinance, may authorize the sale and distribution of draft  
24 beer for on-premises consumption by retail licensees of the  
25 Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. Notwithstanding the  
26 foregoing, keg beer may not be sold for off-premises  
27 consumption.

1                   Section 3. Prior to the enacting of any ordinance or  
2 resolution authorizing the sale and distribution of draft  
3 beer, the city council shall call a special election or an  
4 election in conjunction with the next municipal general  
5 election for the city to determine whether draft beer may be  
6 sold for on-premises consumption at restaurants in the city of  
7 Prattville that are licensed by the Alcoholic Beverage Control  
8 Board to sell alcoholic beverages and to require each  
9 establishment that is licensed to sell draft beer in the City  
10 of Prattville, in Autauga County and Elmore County, to  
11 purchase or lease all equipment necessary to dispense the  
12 beer. On the ballot to be used for the referendum election,  
13 the question shall be in the following form: "Do you favor the  
14 enactment of SB \_ 2011 Regular Session of the Legislature,  
15 which authorizes the city council, by resolution or ordinance,  
16 to authorize the sale and distribution of draft beer for  
17 on-premises consumption by retail licensees of the Alcoholic  
18 Beverage Control Board? Yes \_ No \_."

19                   Section 4. If this act is approved by a majority of  
20 the voters in the City of Prattville, the city council may  
21 regulate, by ordinance, the sale of draft beer for on-premises  
22 consumption only by retail licensees of the Alcoholic Beverage  
23 Control Board within the corporate limits of the city as  
24 provided in Section 2. If this act is not approved by a  
25 majority of the voters, draft beer shall not be sold within  
26 the city of Prattville.

1                   Section 5. This act shall become effective  
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
