7 Relating to Jefferson County in the Tenth Judicial
8 Circuit; to amend Section 1 of Act 2009-612, 2009 Regular
9 Session (Acts 2009, p. 1775); to provide further for the
10 distribution of the solicitor's fee to the circuit or
11 municipal court clerk and the Solicitor's Fund in the
12 Birmingham Division and the Bessemer Division of the County.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

14 Section 1. Section 1 of Act 2009-612, 2009 Regular
15 Session (Acts 2009, p. 1775), is amended to read as follows:

16 "Section 1. In all juvenile, traffic, criminal, and
17 quasi-criminal cases in the juvenile, district, circuit, and
18 municipal courts in the Birmingham Division and the Bessemer
19 Division of Jefferson County, a docket fee, hereinafter
20 referred to as a solicitor's fee, shall be assessed in each
21 case. The fees, when collected, shall be distributed monthly
22 as follows: Three dollars (\$3) from each case to the circuit
23 clerk to be deposited into the circuit clerk's fund or, if the
24 case originates in the municipal court, three dollars (\$3) to
25 the municipal court clerk to be deposited into the municipal

1 clerk's fund or the fund otherwise established for the
2 operation of the office of the municipal court, to be used as
3 provided by law for the operation of the office of the circuit
4 court clerk or municipal court clerk as the case may be and
5 the remainder of each fee to the Solicitor's Fund or District
6 Attorney's Fund in the division of the county where the case
7 originated or to the fund in each division that may be
8 hereafter prescribed by law for the solicitor's fee. The
9 solicitor's fee shall be in an amount not less than an amount
10 equal to all docket fees or court costs which are assessed
11 upon an adjudication of guilt in a criminal case and
12 distributed to the Fair Trial Tax Fund. In no event shall the
13 solicitor's fee be less than an amount equal to the Fair Trial
14 Tax Fund docket fee which are prescribed for an adjudication
15 or finding of guilt of the criminal offense charged."

16 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
17 first day of the third month following its passage and
18 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
