Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Landowners Protection Act."

4 Section 2. (a) A landowner who leases property for 5 hunting or fishing purposes shall not be liable for any 6 damages to any person based on the use of the leased property 7 for hunting or fishing purposes.

8 (b) This act shall not affect the liability of a 9 third party leasing the land.

Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are repealed.

12 Section 4. This act shall become effective on the 13 first day of the third month following its passage and 14 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
