13	WHEREAS, the economy of the areas of this State was
14	adversely affected by the recent tornadoes; and
15	WHEREAS, buildings and other structures owned by
16	local school systems and local governmental entities were
17	damaged or destroyed by the tornadoes; and
18	WHEREAS, Alabamians pay taxes to make it possible to
19	repair the buildings and other structures owned by local
20	systems and local governmental entities that were damaged or
21	destroyed by the tornadoes; and
22	WHEREAS, it would be positive for the morale of the
23	residents adversely affected by the tornadoes as well as the
24	local economy if, to the extent possible, local school systems
25	and local governmental entities hire or use local and in-state
26	contractors to rebuild or repair buildings damaged or
27	destroyed by the tornadoes; and

WHEREAS, Alabama has local and in-state contractors who are well-trained and who have the ability to rebuild or repair buildings damaged or destroyed by the tornadoes; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That this Legislature strongly urges, and indeed expects to the extent possible that local school systems and local governmental entities hire or use local and in-state contractors to rebuild or repair buildings that were damaged or destroyed by the tornadoes.
