8 news of the death of Mr. James Edward "Jim" Pyburn of Smith
9 Lake, Alabama, on May 21, 2011, at the age of 78 years; and

11 University, he was an All-American in football and a stand out
12 baseball player which led his playing three seasons with the
13 Baltimore Orioles; and

15 coached football and was an associate football coach at the
16 University of Georgia from 1964 to 1979; and

17 WHEREAS, his life in athletics was honored in 2000
18 when he was inducted in the Alabama Sports Hall of Fame; and

20 Lottie Stringellow and Ralph Richard Pyburn; and his sisters,
21 Dorothy Pyburn Best and Lee Pyburn Kiser; and

22 WHEREAS, left to cherish his memory are his wife of
23 57 years, Ann Waggoner Pyburn; sons, Jeffrey Thomas Pyburn
24 (Melanie) and Matthew Harris Pyburn (Elizabeth); brother,

1 Ralph Richard Pyburn, Jr., and grandchildren, Jay Pyburn,
2 Aubrey Pyburn and Will Pyburn; and

3 WHEREAS, Mr. Pyburn was a valued member of the
