3 WHEREAS, the Guardians of Freedom Act of 2011, 4 sponsored by Senator Jay Rockefeller in the U.S. Senate and by 5 Representative Nick Rahall in the U.S. House of 6 Representatives, would give the National Guard Bureau Chief 7 the same status as the other Joint Chiefs of Staff and would 8 enable him or her to vote on decisions that affect the 9 National Guard; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we hereby urge Congress to enact the Guardians of Freedom Act of 2011 to enhance the roles and responsibilities of the Chief of the National Guard Bureau by requiring the Chief to be a member of the Joint Chiefs of Staff.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be made available for the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, and the members of the Alabama Congressional Delegation.
