11 its third consecutive National Championship by defeating the  
12 University of Wisconsin Whitewater 58-56 in a playoff  
13 tournament; and

14 WHEREAS, this outstanding team completed the season  
15 with a 24-8 record and advanced to the national finals for the  
16 fourth consecutive year; and

17 WHEREAS, the Crimson Tide was paced in the  
18 championship game by a 20-point, 13-rebound effort from  
19 Karolina Lingyte and a 14-point, 10-rebound effort from Elisha  
20 Williams, and outstanding 10-point productions from Cindy  
21 Ouelett and Katie Hamock; and

22 WHEREAS, at the national awards banquet after the  
23 tournament, Annika Zeyen, Emily Seelenfreund, and Lindsey Metz  
24 were named to the Academic All-American Team, with Lingyte,  
25 Hamock, and Zeyen making the All-American first team, with
