9 WHEELCHAIR BASKETBALL TEAM FOR WINNING A THIRD CONSECUTIVE
10 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.

12 WHEREAS, in Arlington, Texas, on March 13, 2011, The
13 University of Alabama Women's Wheelchair Basketball Team won
14 its third consecutive National Championship by defeating the
15 University of Wisconsin Whitewater 58-56 in a playoff
16 tournament; and

17 WHEREAS, this outstanding team completed the season
18 with a 24-8 record and advanced to the national finals for the
19 fourth consecutive year; and

20 WHEREAS, the Crimson Tide was paced in the
21 championship game by a 20-point, 13-rebound effort from
22 Karolina Lingyte and a 14-point, 10-rebound effort from Elisha
23 Williams, and outstanding 10-point productions from Cindy
24 Ouelett and Katie Hamock; and

25 WHEREAS, at the national awards banquet after the
26 tournament, Annika Zeyen, Emily Seelenfreund, and Lindsey Metz
27 were named to the Academic All-American Team, with Lingyte,

1 Hamock, and Zeyen making the All-American first team, with
2 Ouelett and Williams making the second team, and Mackenzie
3 Soldan and Williams making the all-rookie team; now therefore,
