10 WHEREAS, every year, tens of thousands of American
11 workers are killed by workplace injuries and occupational
12 disease; and

13 WHEREAS, tens of thousands more are permanently
14 disabled; and

15 WHEREAS, millions more are injured or made ill; and

16 WHEREAS, concerned Americans are determined to
17 prevent these tragedies by observing Workers Memorial Day on
18 April 28, 2011, as a day to remember these victims of
19 workplace injuries and disease by renewing our efforts to seek
20 stronger safety and health protections, better standards and
21 enforcement, and fair and just compensation, and by
22 rededicating ourselves to improving safety and health in every
23 workplace; now therefore,

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
25 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That April 28, 2011, be declared
26 Workers Memorial Day in the State of Alabama, in recognition
27 of workers killed, injured, and disabled on the job.
