19	To propose an amendment to the Constitution of
20	Alabama of 1901, as amended, to authorize an incentive program

24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
25	Section 1. The following amendment to the
26	Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and
27	shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a

majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Part 1. The Legislature makes the following findings:

- (1) The economic well-being of the citizens of the state will be enhanced by the increased development and growth of industry within the state and it is in the best interests of the state to provide for certain incentives to allow the state to promote such economic development through the recruitment, retention, and expansion of quality projects within the state.
- (2) The incentives provided in House Bill ____ or Senate Bill ____ of the Regular Session of 2012 of the Alabama Legislature will assist the state in encouraging the retention of existing jobs that may otherwise be terminated or displaced, and the creation of new jobs which may not otherwise exist within the state, and the incentives will help retain and create sources of tax revenues for the state and its political subdivisions.
- (3) The powers to be granted and the purposes to be accomplished by House Bill ___ or Senate Bill ___ of the Regular Session of 2012 of the Alabama Legislature are proper governmental and public purposes and the inducement of the recruitment, retention, or expansion of quality projects within the state is of paramount importance.

1 Part II. Notwithstanding any other provision of this 2 Constitution, the provisions of House Bill or Senate Bill ___ [Act No. 2012-] of the Regular Session of 2012 of the 3 Alabama Legislature are hereby authorized, validated, enabled, 5 confirmed, and ratified in all respects and, as such, shall be immune from any challenge based on either this Constitution or 6 7 any other law of the State of Alabama. Section 2. Upon enactment of either House Bill 8 9 or Senate Bill of the Regular Session of 2012 of the Alabama Legislature, an election upon the proposed amendment 10 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 11 12 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 13 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 14 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 15 state. 16 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 17 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 18 following description of the substance or subject matter of 19 20 the proposed constitutional amendment: 21 "Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 22 Alabama of 1901, to authorize an incentive program which the 23 state may use for the purpose of creating and retaining jobs 24 and promoting economic and industrial development in the 25 state. "Proposed by Act ." 26

This description shall be followed by the following language:
