14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. Sections 17-16-2 and 17-16-2.1, as
16	amended by Act 2011-147 of the 2011 Regular Session, of the
17	Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:
18	"§17-16-2.
19	"As used in this chapter, the term "expenses" shall
20	include, but not be limited to, the following items and any
21	other items approved as reimbursable expenses by the Election
22	Expense Reimbursement Committee Comptroller pursuant to
23	Section 17-16-2.1:
24	"(1) The compensation and mileage provided by law
25	for election officials and any extraordinary labor costs
26	incurred by the county for election functions and duties,
27	including, but not limited to, compensation for temporary

1	workers and overtime for employees of the county or sheriff's
2	office, provided such additional costs are necessary and
3	directly related to functions and duties necessary for
4	conducting the election.
5	"(2) The compensation provided by law for the clerk
6	or other official acting as absentee election manager.
7	"(3) The Any necessary costs associated with
8	programming or testing election equipment prior to an election
9	and the costs of ballots, supplies, and other materials or
10	equipment necessary for election officials to conduct
11	elections as required by law and as certified by the judge of
12	probate as chief election official of the county.
13	"(4) The costs of absentee ballots, supplies,
14	postage, and other materials required by law to be furnished
15	to the absentee election manager.
16	"(5) The cost of preparing and furnishing the lists
17	of qualified electors to the election officials as required by
18	law.
19	"(6) The cost of publishing any notice or other item
20	related to any election and required by law, including, but
21	not limited to, the publication of notice of any election and
22	any voter lists.
23	"(7) Any other reasonable and necessary election
24	costs not specifically set out herein provided adequate
25	documentation of the expense and reason therefor is submitted

by the county seeking reimbursement.

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1	"(a) There is hereby established an Election Expense
2	Reimbursement Committee designated to identify any election
3	costs not included in Section 17-16-2, which costs shall

"(b) The committee shall meet not less than 90 days prior to the any state primary set for June 2012 to develop and approve the a list of reimbursable expenses for the upcoming election cycle. After Once the list has been approved by the committee, it shall be forwarded to the Comptroller's office. The Comptroller shall determine which items included on the recommended list shall be approved for reimbursement to counties. If the Comptroller does not include an item on the recommended list on the list of approved expenses, the Comptroller shall provide the committee with a detailed explanation of the reasons therefor. The Comptroller shall distribute the list of approved expenses to the chair of each county commission and each probate judge in the state no later than 60 days prior to the date of the primary. The list of approved expenses shall apply in all elections and remain in effect until and unless amended by the committee Comptroller at least 90 days prior to the primary in a subsequent election cycle."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
