19 Relating to the Alabama Law Institute; to authorize  
20 the Alabama Law Institute to receive direct grants or  
21 contributions from municipal, county, state, federal, or  
22 charitable sources, or any other sources, to conduct studies,  
23 educate public officials, and carry on the duties of the Law  
24 Institute.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

26 Section 1. Section 29-8-6 is added to the Code of  
27 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

1                   §29-8-6.

2                   The Alabama Law Institute may establish a special  
3 fund in the State Treasury to receive direct grants or  
4 contributions from municipal, county, state, federal, or  
5 charitable sources, or any other sources, to conduct studies,  
6 educate public officials, and carry on the duties of the Law  
7 Institute. The funds in the special fund are continuously  
8 appropriated for the exclusive use of the Law Institute, shall  
9 be maintained separately, and shall be in addition to any  
10 other funds appropriated to the Law Institute.

11                  Section 2. This act shall become effective  
12 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
13 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
