2 The Alabama Law Institute may establish a special fund in the State Treasury to receive direct grants or 3 contributions from municipal, county, state, federal, or 4 charitable sources, or any other sources, to conduct studies, 5 educate public officials, and carry on the duties of the Law 6 7 Institute. The funds in the special fund are continuously appropriated for the exclusive use of the Law Institute, shall 8 be maintained separately, and shall be in addition to any 9 10 other funds appropriated to the Law Institute.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
