13 Relating to Fayette, Lamar, and Pickens Counties; to
14 provide that any person employed as an investigator by the
15 Twenty-fourth Judicial Circuit who serves for 10 years or more
16 and leaves the office in good standing shall receive, at the
17 district attorney's discretion, his or her service pistol and
18 badge; to provide that investigators for the District Attorney
19 of the Twenty-fourth Judicial Circuit shall be hired pursuant
20 to law; and to repeal Act 88-324 of the 1988 Regular Session
21 (Acts 1988, p. 492).

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

23 Section 1. (a) Any person employed as an
24 investigator for the District Attorney of the Twenty-fourth
25 Judicial Circuit, composed of Fayette, Lamar, and Pickens
26 Counties, for a period of 10 years or more who leaves the
27 office in good standing, by retirement or otherwise, shall

1 receive from the office, at the discretion of the district
2 attorney, without cost to him or her, his or her service
3 pistol and badge.

4 (b) Investigators for the District Attorney in the
5 Twenty-fourth Judicial Circuit shall be employed under the
6 general law pursuant to Section 12-17-220.1 of the Code of
7 Alabama 1975. Act 88-324 of the 1988 Regular Session (Acts
8 1988, p. 492), relating to investigators for the District
9 Attorney in the Twenty-fourth Judicial Circuit is repealed.

10 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
11 first day of the third month following its passage and
12 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
