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9 A BILL  
10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT  
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13 Relating to Marshall County; to amend Section 1 of  
14 Act 2011-527, 2011 Regular Session, providing for the  
15 distribution of additional TVA in-lieu-of-taxes payments  
16 received by the county pursuant to Act 2010-135 to the school  
17 systems in the county for payments to teachers achieving  
18 National Board Certification.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

20 Section 1. (a) The increase in TVA in-lieu-of-taxes  
21 payments to Marshall County generated by Act 2010-135, 2010  
22 Regular Session, to the counties served by the TVA shall be  
23 distributed as follows:

24 (1) Twenty-five percent of the total amount to the  
25 Marshall County Board of Education, the Arab City Board of  
26 Education, the Guntersville City Board of Education, the  
27 Albertville City Board of Education, and the Boaz City Board

1 of Education on a per pupil basis based upon the student  
2 enrollment of the respective school systems on the last day of  
3 the first monthly attendance report of each school year. If  
4 the amount to paid to teachers who have achieved National  
5 Board Certification by this state is less than five thousand  
6 dollars (\$5,000), these funds shall be used to pay teachers  
7 the difference in the amount paid and five thousand dollars  
8 (\$5,000) each year. Any remaining funds may be used at the  
9 discretion of the board.

10 (2) Seventy-five percent to a county discretionary  
11 fund. Moneys in the discretionary fund may be expended for any  
12 lawful purpose by warrant drawn upon the fund pursuant to the  
13 direction of a discretionary fund committee.

14 (b) The Discretionary Fund Committee is created. The  
15 committee shall be comprised of three members as follows:

16 (1) One member who is a resident of Marshall County,  
17 to be appointed by the state Senator representing Marshall  
18 County.

19 (2) Two members, one to be appointed by each of the  
20 members of the House of Representatives representing Marshall  
21 County. Each of these members shall be a resident of the  
22 legislative district of the respective appointing House  
23 member.

24 (c) The distributions made pursuant to this act  
25 shall be made separate and apart from all other TVA  
26 in-lieu-of-taxes payments required by Marshall County,

1 including, but not limited to, those payments distributed  
2 pursuant to Act 2007-498, 2007 Regular Session.

3 Section 2. This act shall become effective  
4 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
5 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
