8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would provide a two-term limit for  
9 the mayor of a Class 1 municipality.

11 A BILL  
12 TO BE ENTITLED  
13 AN ACT

14  
15 Relating to any Class 1 municipality; to amend  
16 Section 11-46-8, Code of Alabama 1975, to provide a term limit  
17 for the mayor.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. Section 11-46-8, Code of Alabama 1975, is  
20 amended to read as follows:

21 "§11-46-8.

22 "(a) This section shall only apply in a Class 1  
23 municipality.

24 "(b) Commencing with the municipal election in 2011,  
25 the mayor shall be elected for a two-year term of office.  
26 Commencing with the municipal election in 2013, and  
27 thereafter, the mayor and the members of the city council

1 shall be elected at the same election for a four-year term of  
2 office.

3 "(c) Commencing with the municipal election in 2013,  
4 and thereafter, the mayor shall serve no more than two  
5 consecutive full terms of office."

6 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the  
7 first day of the third month following its passage and  
8 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
