Section 1. (a) If restitution is ordered by the court pursuant to Section 15-18-67, and the victim is a recipient of medical assistance from the Medicaid Agency or other state agency administering a state or federally funded, or both, health care program for whom expenditures were made as a result of the offender's criminal activities, restitution shall be made to the Medicaid Agency or other state agency administering a state or federally funded, or both, health care program in the same manner as other restitution payments.

(b) Victims shall be paid in full before any other fees subject to reimbursement are paid.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
