2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to the Prepaid Affordable College Tuition
4 (PACT) Program, to amend Sections 16-33C-16 and 16-33C-20 of
5 the Code of Alabama 1975, retroactive to their date of
6 enactment; to add Section 16-33C-23 to the Code of Alabama
7 1975; to repeal Section 16-33C-17 of the Code of Alabama 1975,
8 retroactive to its date of enactment; to provide that payments
9 of tuition and mandatory fees by the PACT Program to instate
10 public institutions of higher education between the effective
11 date of Act 2010-725 and the effective date hereof shall be
12 deemed full payment; to repeal Section 16-33C-19 of the Code
13 of Alabama 1975, retroactive to its date of enactment; and to
14 expressly grant the PACT Board all necessary authority to
15 pursue solutions to any actuarial deficit in the PACT Trust
16 Fund.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

18 Section 1. Sections 16-33C-16 and 16-33C-20 of the
19 Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

20 "§16-33C-16.

21 "~~(a)~~ In addition to the appropriations made in
22 Section 16-33C-14 and Section 16-33C-15, there is annually
23 appropriated from the Education Trust Fund to the PACT Trust
24 Fund the following amounts in the following fiscal years:

25 "(1) For the fiscal year ending 2016 -- \$10,000,000

1 "(2) For the fiscal year ending 2017 -- \$20,000,000

2 "(3) For the fiscal year ending 2018 -- \$20,000,000

3 "(4) For the fiscal year ending 2019 -- \$13,000,000

4 "~~(b) These appropriations, along with the~~
5 ~~appropriations made in Section 16-33C-14 and Section~~
6 ~~16-33C-15, will make the PACT Program 100 percent fully~~
7 ~~funded, according to the actuarial professional retained by~~
8 ~~the PACT board.~~

9 "§16-33C-20.

10 "In the event that the PACT Program's Board of
11 Directors receives an actuarial report certifying that any
12 appropriation made in Section 16-33C-14, Section 16-33C-15, or
13 Section 16-33C-16 is no longer necessary ~~for the PACT Program~~
14 ~~to be fully funded~~, the PACT Program's Board of Directors
15 shall certify to the Legislature that no future appropriations
16 are necessary."

17 Section 2. Section 16-33C-23 is added to the Code of
18 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

19 §16-33C-23.

20 The PACT Board is expressly authorized to negotiate,
21 accept, and implement a legally binding resolution with PACT
22 purchasers and beneficiaries to address any actuarial deficit
23 in the PACT Trust Fund, which includes all powers granted
24 elsewhere in this chapter and all other powers necessary or
25 convenient under this section.

1 Section 3. Section 16-33C-17 of the Code of Alabama
2 1975, is hereby repealed. This repeal is declared to be
3 remedial and curative and is retroactive to April 30, 2010;
4 provided, however, any payments of mandatory fees or tuition
5 per credit hour made by the PACT Program to any instate public
6 institutions of higher education between the effective date of
7 Act 2010-725 and the effective date hereof shall be deemed
8 full payment of such mandatory fees or tuition per credit hour
9 on behalf of the beneficiary of the PACT Contract.

10 Section 4. Section 16-33C-19 of the Code of Alabama
11 1975, is hereby repealed. This repeal is declared to be
12 remedial and curative and is retroactive to April 30, 2010.

13 Section 5. The foregoing amendments of Sections
14 16-33C-16 and 16-33C-20 of the Code of Alabama 1975, are
15 declared remedial and curative and are retroactive to April
16 30, 2010.

17 Section 6. This act shall become effective
18 immediately following its passage and approval by the
19 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
