8 To provide for the transfer of certain state funds  
9 into the State General Fund to help offset the costs of  
10 services provided by agencies which receive appropriations  
11 from the State General Fund.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

13 Section 1. In order to provide for an increase in  
14 receipts into the State General Fund for the fiscal year end-  
15 ing September 30, 2013 there is hereby established the author-  
16 ity to transfer from the following state funds the amounts as  
17 specified in the State General Fund appropriations act for  
18 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013. Such transfer shall  
19 be for the purpose of providing funds to help offset the costs  
20 of state services provided by state entities which receive  
21 appropriations from the State General Fund for operating ex-  
22 penses.
