8 SYNOPSIS: There are currently several funds in the  
9 state accounting system which support specific  
10 functions of government. The state general fund,  
11 which is appropriated for the Executive,  
12 Legislative and Judicial functions of the state,  
13 does not receive a portion of some of these funds  
14 in order to help offset the costs of providing  
15 services such as accounting, auditing, budgeting,  
16 and legal services. This bill will authorize the  
17 transfer of certain funds into the State General  
18 Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013.

21 TO BE ENTITLED  
22 AN ACT

24 To provide for the transfer of certain state funds  
25 into the State General Fund to help offset the costs of  
26 services provided by agencies which receive appropriations  
27 from the State General Fund.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. In order to provide for an increase in  
3 receipts into the State General Fund for the fiscal year end-  
4 ing September 30, 2013 there is hereby established the author-  
5 ity to transfer from the following state funds the amounts as  
6 specified in the State General Fund appropriations act for  
7 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013. Such transfer shall  
8 be for the purpose of providing funds to help offset the costs  
9 of state services provided by state entities which receive  
10 appropriations from the State General Fund for operating ex-  
11 penses.
