Section 1. In order to provide for an increase in receipts into the State General Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013 there is hereby established the authority to transfer from the following state funds the amounts as specified in the State General Fund appropriations act for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2013. Such transfer shall be for the purpose of providing funds to help offset the costs of state services provided by state entities which receive appropriations from the State General Fund for operating expenses.
