1 (2) Have not committed or participated in an act
2 that would constitute grounds for refusal, suspension, or
3 revocation of a professional license or certificate.

4 (3) Have not been disciplined by an authorized
5 entity or are under investigation, in any jurisdiction, in
6 relation to a professional license or certificate.

7 (4) Pay any required fee and submit to any required
8 criminal or other background check by an authorized board,
9 commission, or agency in the State of Alabama.

10 Section 3. Any eligible individual under Section 2
11 of this act who possesses a valid license or certificate in
12 another state, district, or territory of the United States
13 with licensing or certification requirements greater than or
14 substantially similar to the licensing or certification
15 requirements of the appropriate board, commission, or agency
16 in the State of Alabama may be approved to continue work in
17 his or her profession upon relocation to the State of Alabama
18 for such time as normally allotted with receipt of a license
19 or certificate from the appropriate board, commission, or
20 agency provided that upon completion of an application that
21 documents compliance with the receiving agency's requirements
22 for a certificate or license, an authorized board, commission,
23 or agency shall expedite the application according to statute,
24 promulgated rules, or if applicable, at the next scheduled
25 licensure proceeding for an eligible individual under Section
26 2 of this Act.

1 Section 4. Any board, commission, or agency in the
2 State of Alabama may establish reciprocity with other states
3 for military spouse professional licensing and certification.

4 Section 5. This act does not apply to the practice
5 of law or the regulation of attorneys.

6 Section 6. This act shall become effective on the
7 first day of the third month following its passage and
8 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
