13 Relating to Wilcox County; providing for the
14 assessment and collection of a solicitor's fee payable to the
15 Solicitor's Fund in all civil cases in an amount equal to the
16 fees and court costs payable to the Fair Trial Tax Fund in
17 civil cases; and providing for the disbursement of the fund.
18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. In all civil cases in the Circuit courts
20 and District courts in Wilcox County, a docket fee,
21 hereinafter referred to as a solicitor's fee, shall be
22 assessed in each case. The fees, when collected, shall be
23 distributed monthly as follows: five dollars (\$5) from each
24 case to the office of Circuit Clerk in Wilcox County and the
25 remainder of each fee to the solicitor's fund or district
26 attorney's fund in the county where collected or to the fund
27 in the county that may be hereafter prescribed by law for the

1 solicitor's fee. The solicitor's fee in civil cases shall be
2 in the same amount as the docket fee or costs which are
3 assessed in civil circuit and district court cases in Wilcox
4 County and distributed to the Fair Trial Tax Fund.

5 Section 2. The solicitor's fee may be expended by
6 the district attorney for the payment of any and all expenses
7 incurred or for any legitimate law enforcement purposes. That
8 portion of the fees earmarked for the Office of the Circuit
9 Clerk of Wilcox County may be expended at the request of the
10 Circuit Clerk for any lawful purpose.

11 Section 3. This act shall become effective
12 immediately following its passage and approval by the
13 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
