18	by the county commission and may be expended in conjunction

20	Section 2. Section 1 of this act shall become
21	operative only if approved by a majority of the qualified
22	electors of Bibb County who vote in an election to be held on
23	the day designated by the judge of probate. The notice of the
24	election shall be given by the judge of probate and the
25	election shall be held, conducted, and the results canvassed
26	in the manner as other county elections. The election shall be

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held in conjunction with the next regularly scheduled state or
 county election. The questions shall be:

7 The county shall pay any costs and expenses not otherwise reimbursed by a governmental agency which are 8 incidental to the election. If a majority of the votes cast in 9 10 the election are "Yes," Section 1 of this act shall become 11 operative immediately. If the majority of the votes are "No," 12 this act shall be repealed and shall have no further effect. 13 The judge of probate shall certify the results of the election to the Secretary of State. 14

15 Section 3. This act shall become effective 16 immediately following its passage and approval by the 17 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law and shall be in 18 addition to any laws currently in place.
