8 Deputy Sheriff Thomas R. Lewis for his exceptional service to
9 the Madison County Sheriff's Department, it is with sincere
10 pride and admiration that a portion of U.S. Highway 431
11 Northbound between mile markers 343 and 344 be named the
12 Fallen Officer Highway: Deputy Sheriff Thomas R. Lewis; and

13 WHEREAS, on November 1, 1994, Deputy Lewis was
14 fatally wounded during what should have been a routine task in
15 the line of duty; and

16 WHEREAS, his courage and sacrifice may be honored by
17 recognizing his commitment to the citizens of Madison County
18 and his desire to heed the highest calling of a law
19 enforcement officer, to serve and protect; now therefore,

20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH
21 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That a portion of U.S. Highway 431
22 Northbound in Madison County between mile markers 343 and 344
23 be named the Fallen Officer Highway: Deputy Sheriff Thomas R.
24 Lewis.
