12	United States is born with cystic fibrosis; and
13	WHEREAS, the University of Alabama at Birmingham is
14	an international leader in cystic fibrosis research and
15	clinical care; and
16	WHEREAS, John P. Clancy, M.D., Director of the
17	Pediatric Pulmonary Center at the University of Alabama at
18	Birmingham, was the principal investigator for one of the
19	preliminary drugs aimed at treating the underlying causes of
20	cystic fibrosis; and
21	WHEREAS, prompt, aggressive treatment of the
22	symptoms of cystic fibrosis can extend the lives of people who
23	have the disease; and
24	WHEREAS, education of the public about cystic
25	fibrosis increases the knowledge and understanding of cystic

fibrosis, promotes early diagnosis, and is a key factor in supporting research into the causes and cure; and

WHEREAS, the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation conducts activities throughout the United States in recognition of National Cystic Awareness Month during the month of May each year, and it is appropriate to join other states in the battle to conquer this disease by designating the second week of May as Cystic Fibrosis Awareness Week in Alabama; now therefore,
