WHEREAS, he made a successful transition from his football career to the business world, and for more than four decades was highly regarded as a stock broker and civic leader in Huntsville, where he was also known for his devotion to family; survivors include his wife, Susan Willa Kinzer Neighbors; children, Wes (Phyllis) Neighbors, Claire Neighbors (Bubba) Roby, and Keith (Kim) Neighbors; 10 grandchildren; and one sister Mary Evelyn Neighbors (Chester) Johnson; and
