YVONNE KENNEDY. 9 10 11 WHEREAS, founded in the summer of 1927, Bishop State 12 Community College was originally the Mobile Branch of Alabama 13 State College (University) in Montgomery, Alabama. It was 14 established as an in-service arm of Alabama State College that 15 offered extension courses to African-American elementary and secondary teachers in Mobile; and 16 17 WHEREAS, on February 23, 1989, under the leadership of Dr. Yvonne Kennedy, our friend and colleague, the Alabama 18 State Board of Education renamed the college to Bishop State 19 20 Community College to reflect its growth in vocational/career 21 offerings, transfer offerings and community service 22 activities; on August 22, 1991, the Alabama State Board of 23 Education consolidated two technical colleges in Mobile -24 Southwest State Technical College and Carver State Technical 25 College - with Bishop State Community College; and WHEREAS, in 1995, the college added a fourth campus 26 27 with the opening of its Baker-Gaines Central Campus, formerly

the historic Central High School; the facility now houses the Division of Health Related Professions; in addition, it includes a museum, child care center, 1,200-seat auditorium, multimedia center, cafeteria facilities and a bookstore; and

5 WHEREAS, in 2006, under the leadership of Dr. 6 Kennedy, the College completed construction of the \$10 7 million-plus state of the art Business Technology Center; now 8 therefore,

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA, BOTH 10 HOUSES THEREOF CONCURRING, That we recognize and honor Dr. 11 Yvonne Kennedy by naming the Business Technology Center at 12 Bishop State Community College, the Dr. Yvonne Kennedy 13 Business Technology Center.
