13 (NCIV) since 1996, first as Executive Director and then as
14 President, until September 30, 2011; and

15 WHEREAS, on October 27, 2011, the NCIV Board of
16 Directors named her President Emerita; and

17 WHEREAS, in addition to her long and distinguished
18 career, she is an active volunteer and has served on the
19 boards of various nonprofit organizations including World
20 Learning, the Public Diplomacy Council, Friendship Force,
21 International Business for Diplomatic Action, and the United
22 States Center for Citizen Diplomacy; she serves on the
23 American University School of International Service Dean's
24 Advisory Council and the Advisory Council of the International
25 Student House in Washington, D.C.; and

26 WHEREAS, she has taught English in Brazil,
27 participated in an Experiment in International Living program

1 in Germany, and has traveled extensively throughout Europe and
2 Southeast Asia; in May 2001, she served as a speaker for the
3 United States Department of State in Saudi Arabia, giving
4 lectures and conducting workshops on leadership development
5 for nonprofit organizations; in addition, her published works
6 are widely known and highly regarded; and

7 WHEREAS, in May 2011, One To World presented her
8 with the Fulbright Award for Citizen Diplomacy for "lifelong
9 contributions to global understanding and cooperation," among
10 numerous well-deserved honors she has received through the
11 years; now therefore,
